5. This certificate does not constitute an authorisation to operate the types of aircraft referred to in condition 1. The authorisation to operate the aircraft is the Air Operator Certificate (AOC).
6. Termination, suspension or revocation of the AOC of an air carrier licensed in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1008/2008 automatically invalidates the present certificate in relation to the aircraft registrations specified in the AOC, except when the CAMO is contracted in accordance with point M.A.201(ea) of Annex I (Part – M) to Commission Regulation (EU) No 1321/2014, unless otherwise explicitly stated by the competent authority.
7. Subject to compliance with the previous conditions, this certificate shall remain valid for an unlimited duration unless the certificate has previously been surrendered, superseded, suspended or revoked.
